

Who We Are and What We Do



The Music Guild of New Mexico's Señorita Program was originally created in 1957 as the Doñitas of the Symphony. The original purpose of the program was to give young women of high school age a social setting in which to be presented.

The Señorita Program has evolved since that time and continues to provide a unique opportunity for young women. What began as a selective social debut has become a full year of educational, social, and volunteer activities. The Señorita Program focuses on personal growth and community service to prepare young women for college and adult life. The year culminates with the presentation

of the Señoritas at the annual Señorita Ball.

Señoritas participate in the arts, social etiquette, community service, and college prep activities designed to help broaden their perspectives and prepare them for adulthood.

Becoming a Señorita

Young women who are seniors in high school are eligible, once sponsored by a Member of the Music Guild of NM.

No, you do NOT need to play a musical instrument 😊.

Señoritas learn to waltz, gain poise and confidence in front of large groups, participate in various community service projects, make friends outside your current social circle, and make valuable contacts for letters of reference for college, jobs, and/or sororities.

The Señorita fee is \$2000.
